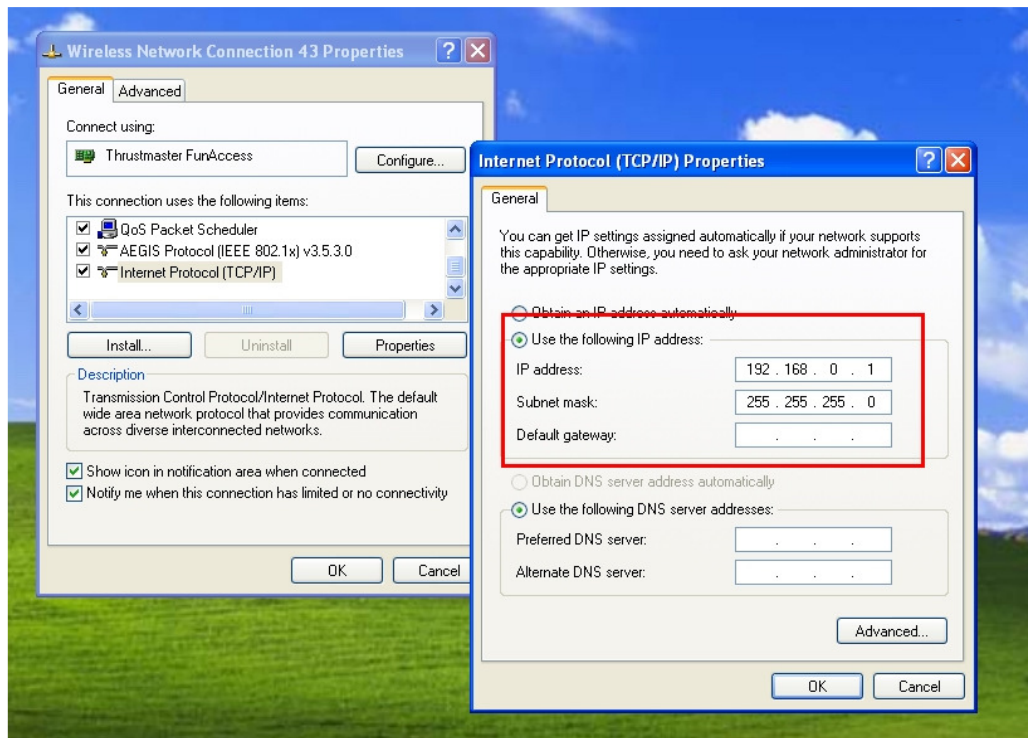


How can I restore my Internet connection sharing?

1. First off, verify that your computer is connected to the Internet. To do so, open a web page (for example: <http://www.hercules.com>).
Reminder: Your computer must be connected to the Internet for connection sharing to function, particularly if you are using a connection via USB modem or Ethernet modem.
2. Next, verify that your FunAccess WiFi USB Key for PS3 is properly connected and that sharing of your Internet connection is enabled. To do so, launch the Thrustmaster utility by clicking **Start/All Programs (or Programs)/Thrustmaster/FunAccess/Share an Internet connection**, then follow the on-screen instructions.
3. Verify the IP address of your FunAccess USB key. To do so, click **Start/(Settings/)Control Panel/Network Connection**. Right-click the **Wireless Network Connection** entry and click **Properties**. Select **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)** and click the **Properties** button. Verify the following settings:



4. If the IP address listed is not correct or if **Obtain an IP address automatically** is selected: select **Use the following IP address** and manually enter the following settings:

IP address:	192.168.0.1
Subnet mask:	255.255.255.0
Default gateway:	[Empty]

5. Close all of the properties windows by clicking **OK** for each one.
