

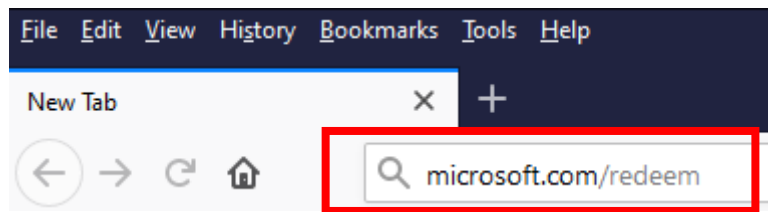
# Quick Start: DTS Headphone:X for Thrustmaster Headsets (PC)

***For Xbox activation, go to page 6***

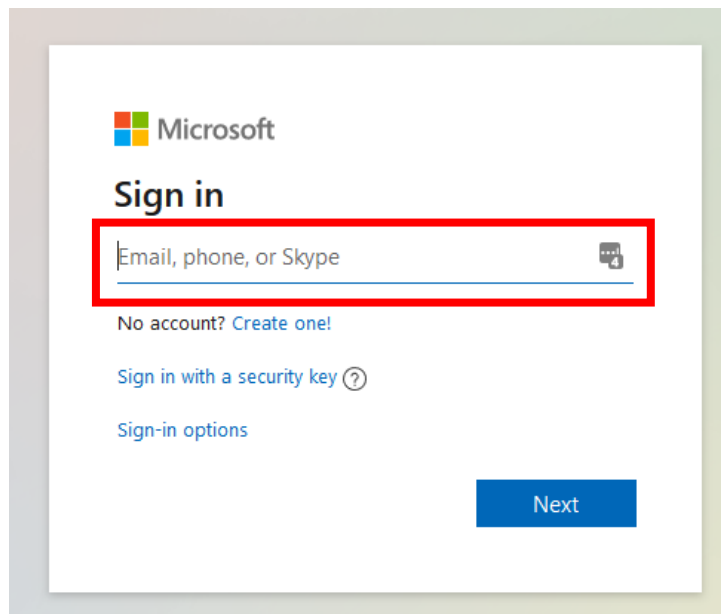
*DTS Sound Unbound is the Windows and Xbox application which enables the use of DTS Headphone:X technology on Windows 10 and Xbox systems.*

*The following steps are only applicable if you have been provided with a DTS Sound Undound license activation code.*

1. Open your web browser, and go to [microsoft.com/redeem](https://microsoft.com/redeem):

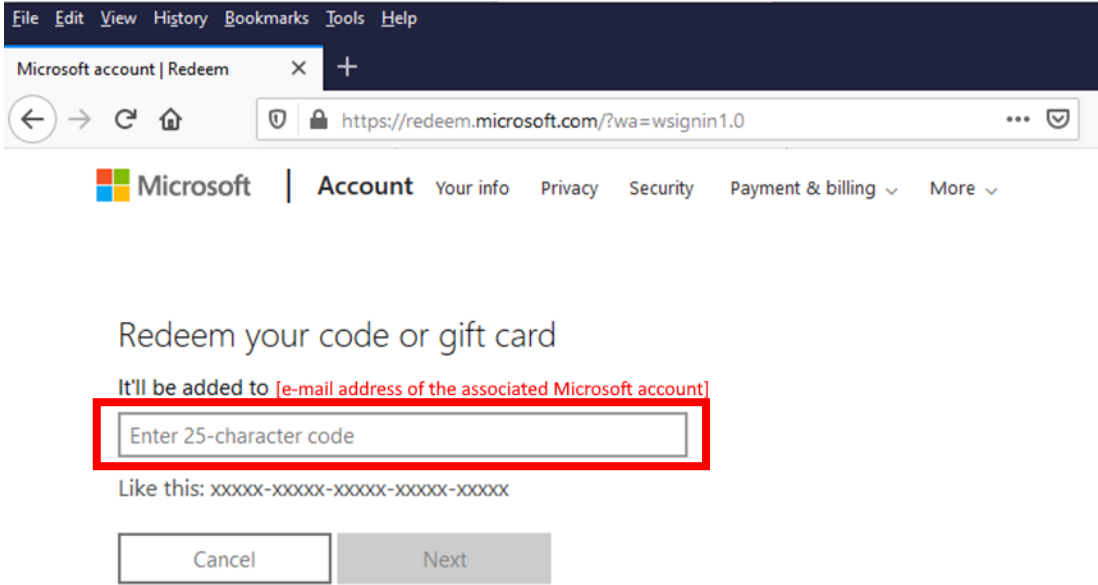


2. Sign into the Microsoft account on which you wish to activate the DTS Sound Unbound license (you may need to create an account if you currently do not have one):

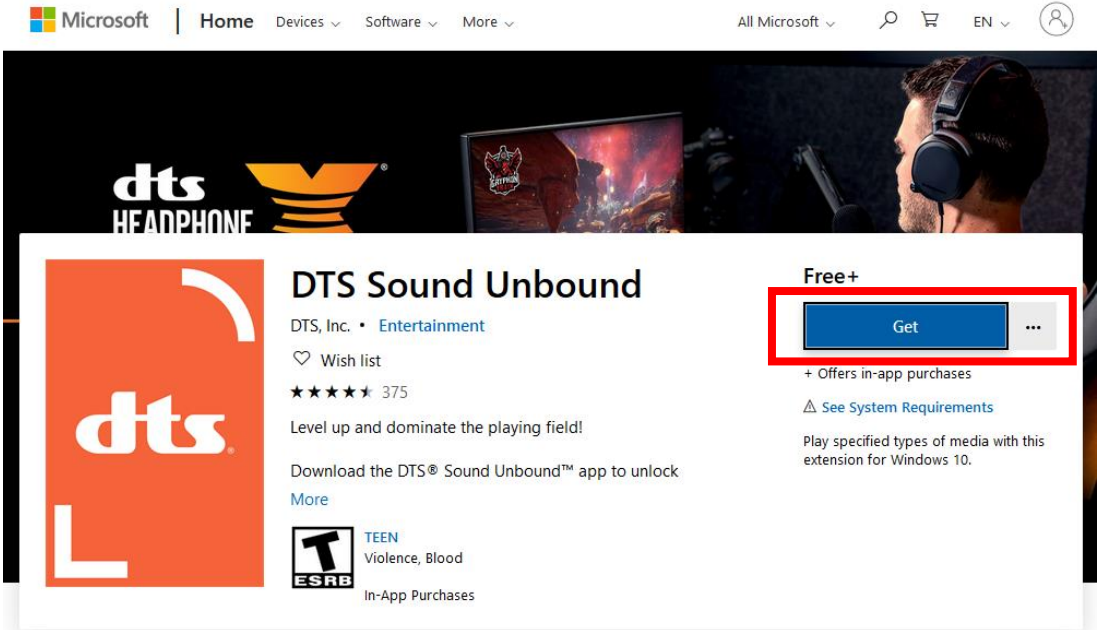

3. You will be automatically redirected to the redeem page where you will be able to enter the 25-character code you have been provided (on the sticker located on the packaging) to unlock your user license:

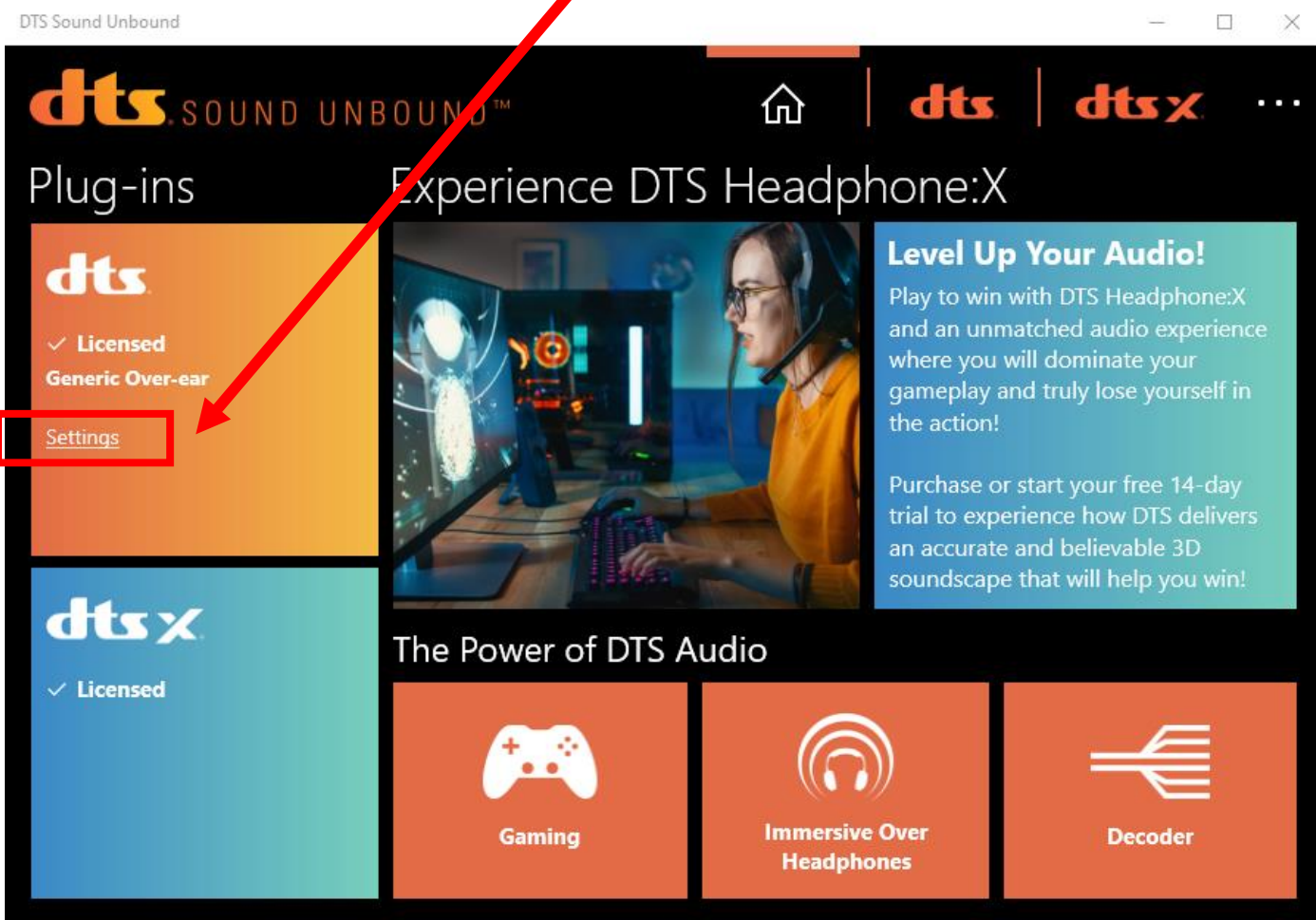


4. Your license will automatically be activated for 1 year, and you will be redirected to the DTS Sound Unbound application page in the Microsoft store. Click on "Get" to download and install the app.



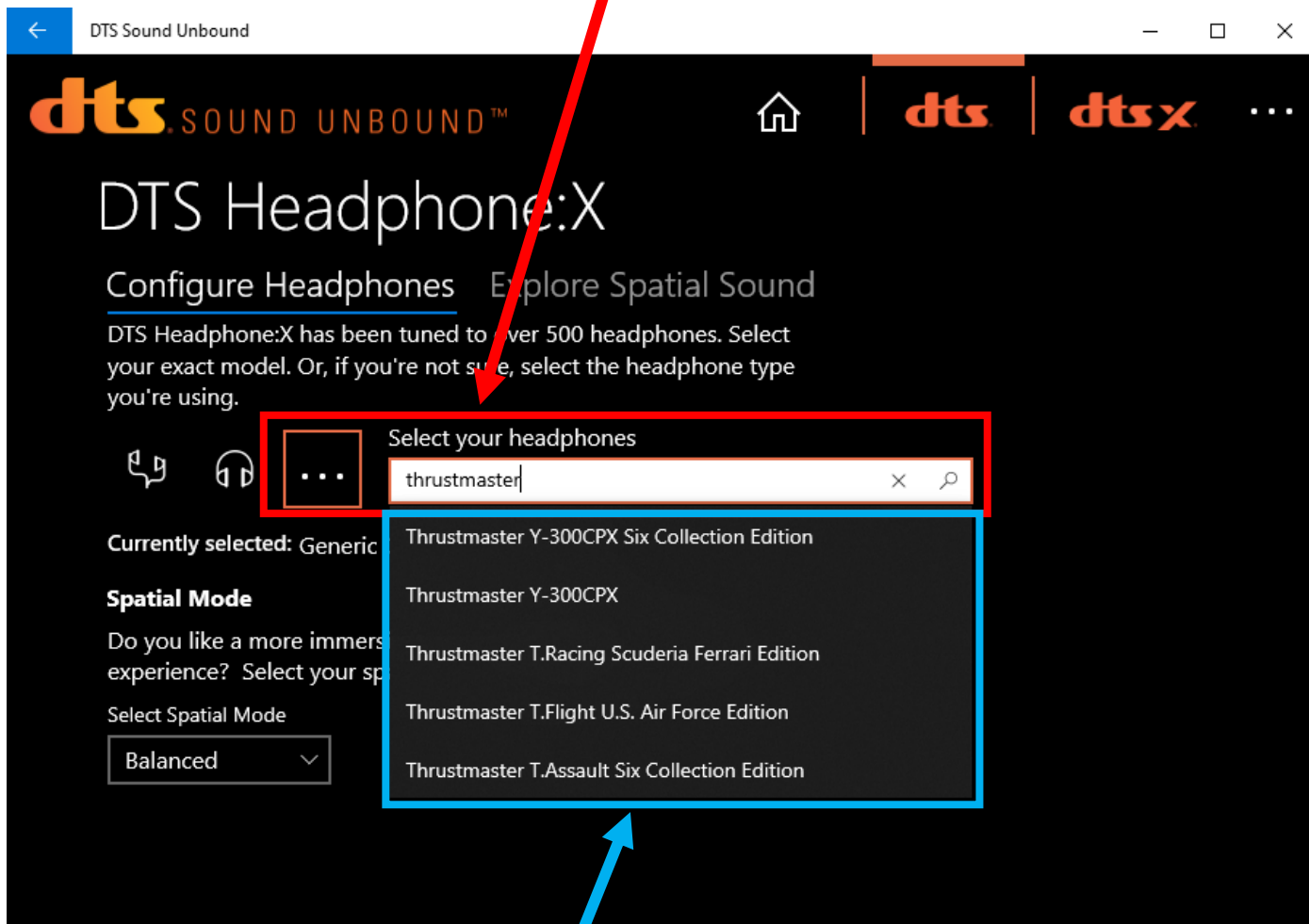

5. After install completion, open the DTS Sound Unbound app and click on "Settings":

6. Click on the three dots to activate the search bar, then type in "Thrustmaster":

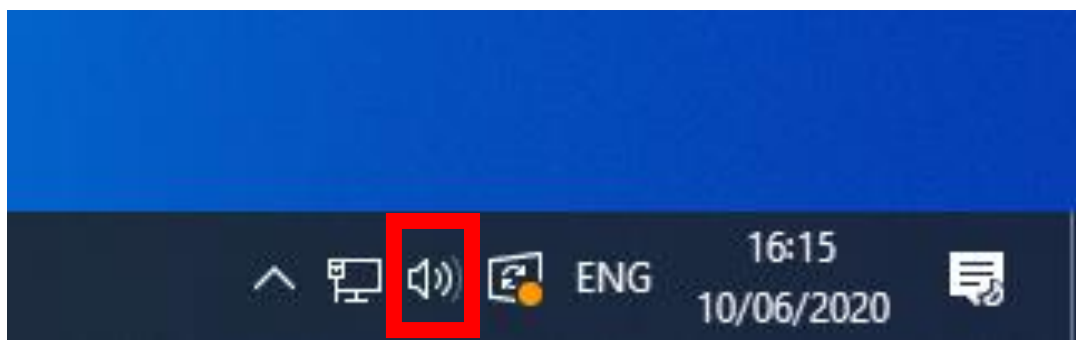


Select your headset model in the dropdown menu; this will activate the recommended EQ setting specifically created by DTS for your Thrustmaster headset.

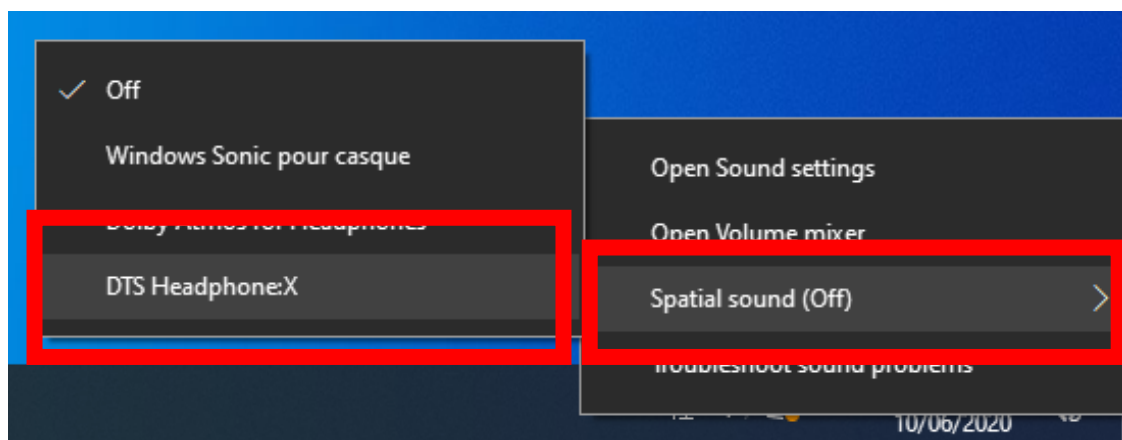

7. Activate DTS Headphone:X in the Windows 10 sound settings:

- Right-click on the sound settings icon of the task bar



- Hover to "Spatial Sound (Off)", then select "DTS Headphone:X"



*DTS Headphone:X is now set up on your PC*

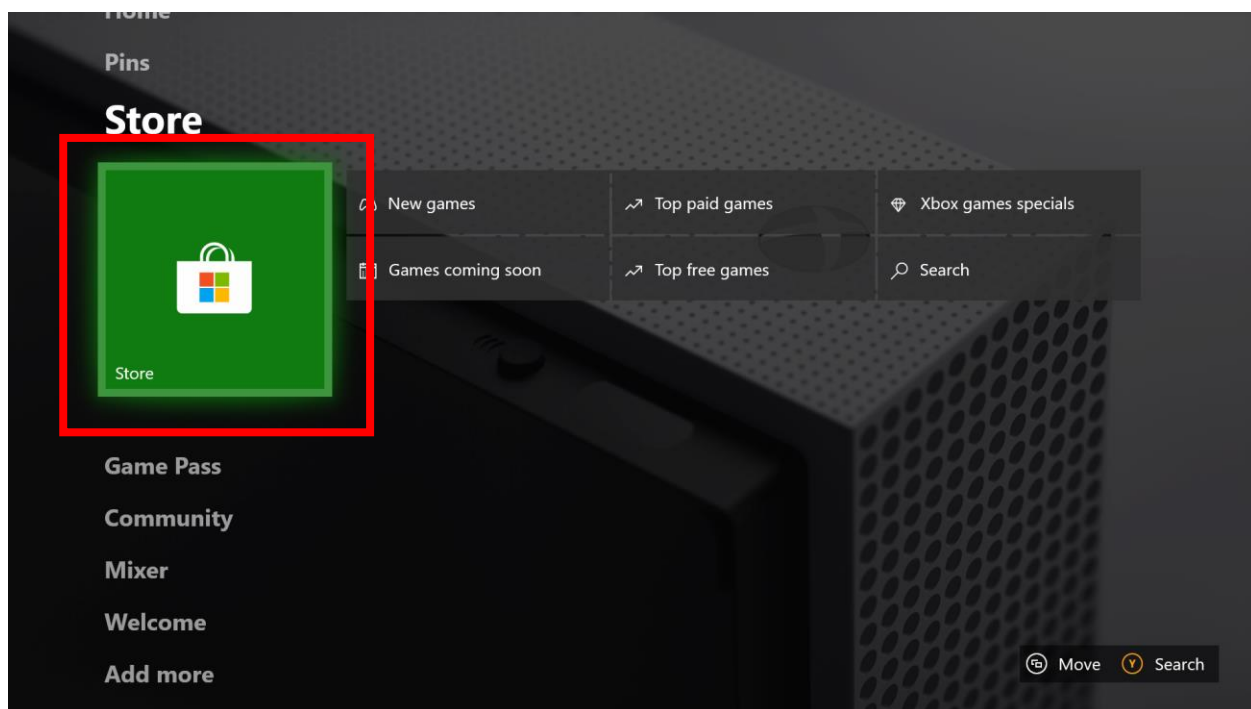

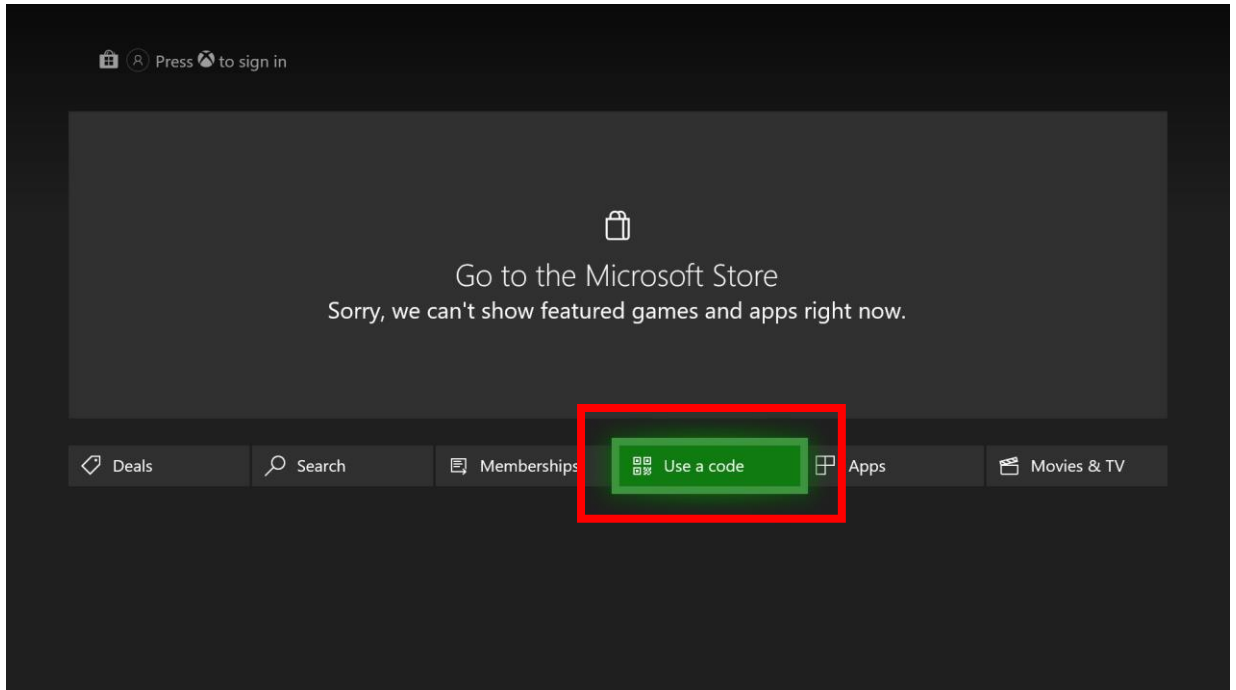

1. Scroll down the main menu of your Xbox to the Store application:

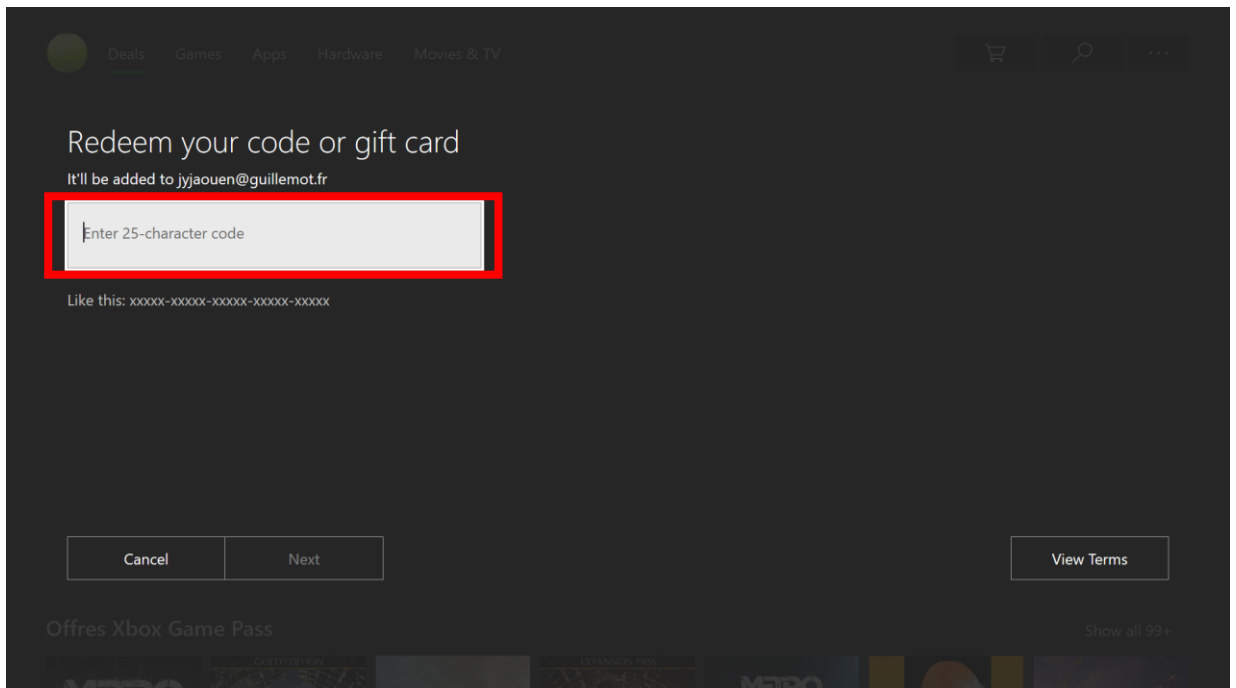

2. In the store, select "Use a code"

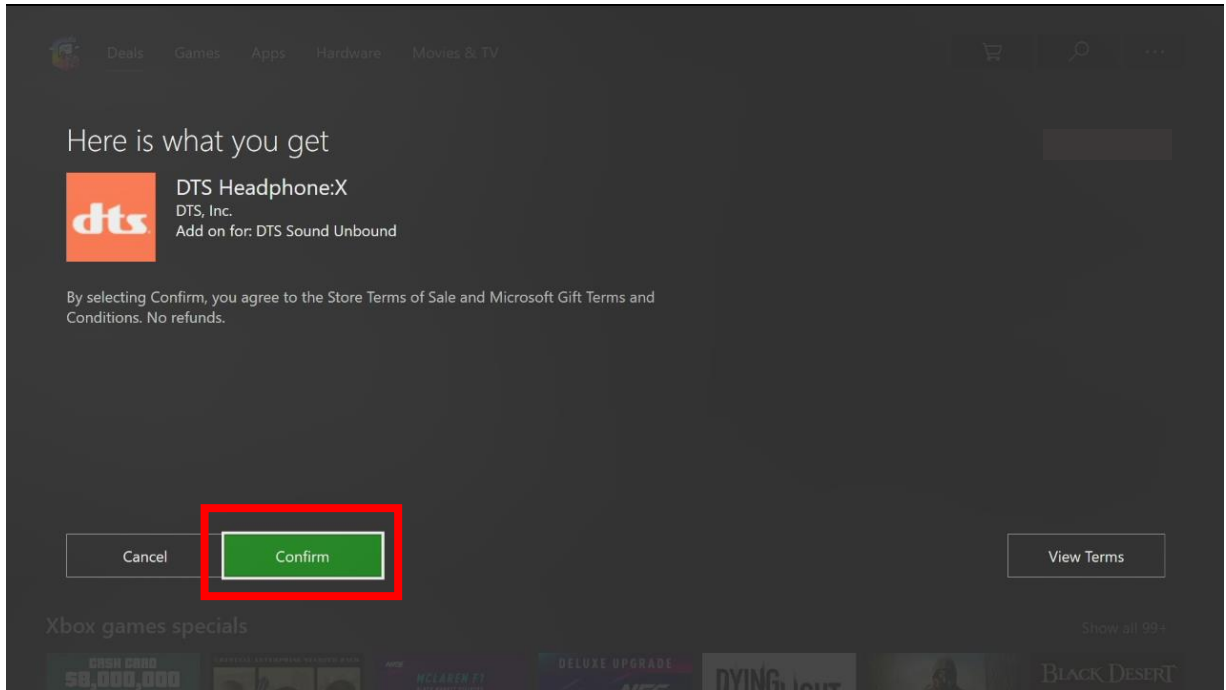


3. Enter the 25-character code you have been provided (on the sticker located on the packaging) to unlock your 1-year user license:

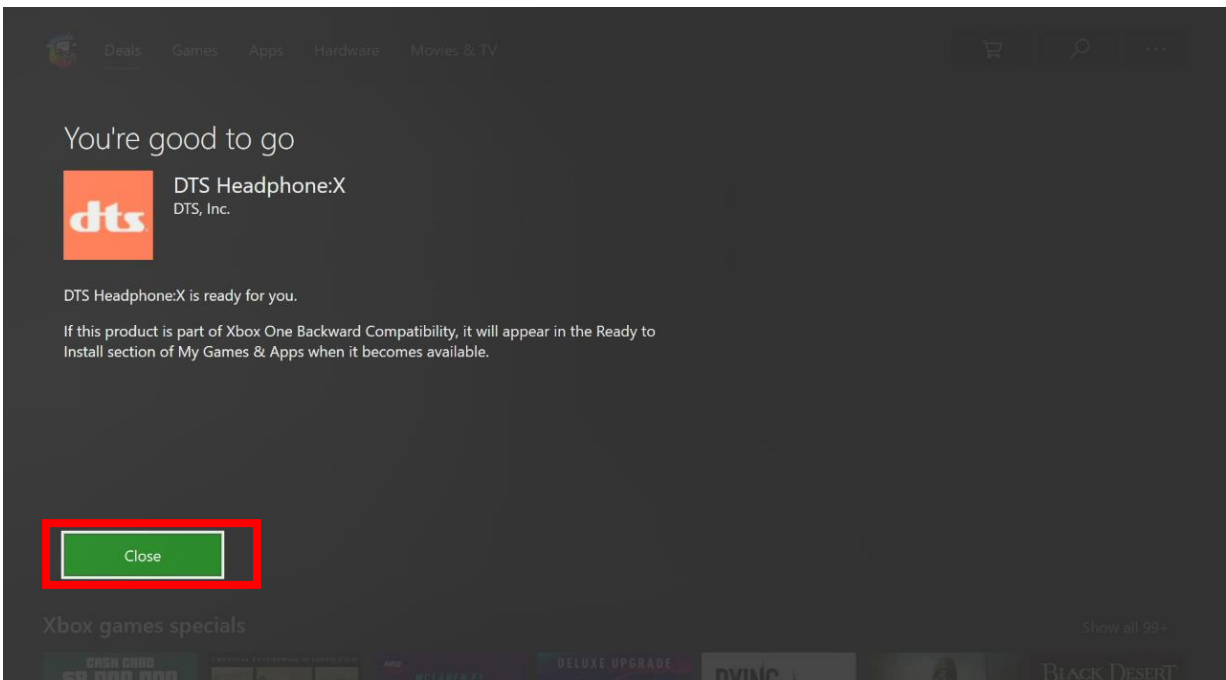

4. You will receive a preview stating you are getting DTS Headphone:X; confirm activation



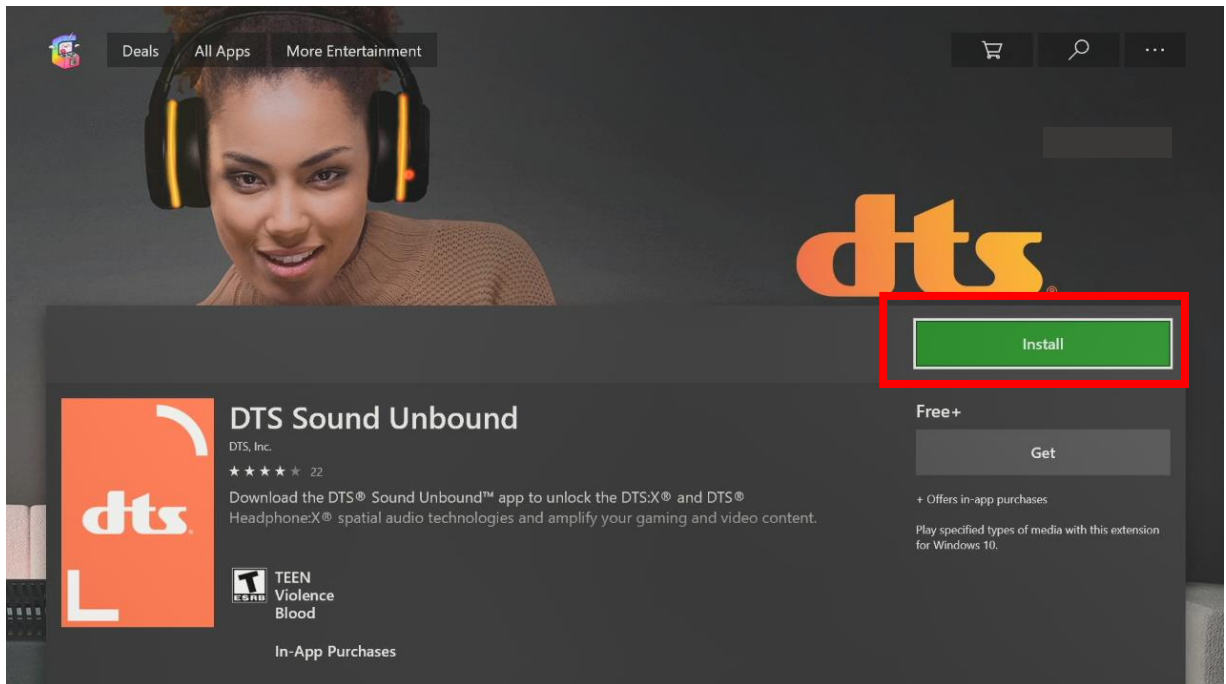
5. You will receive confirmation that the license has been activated; close the page



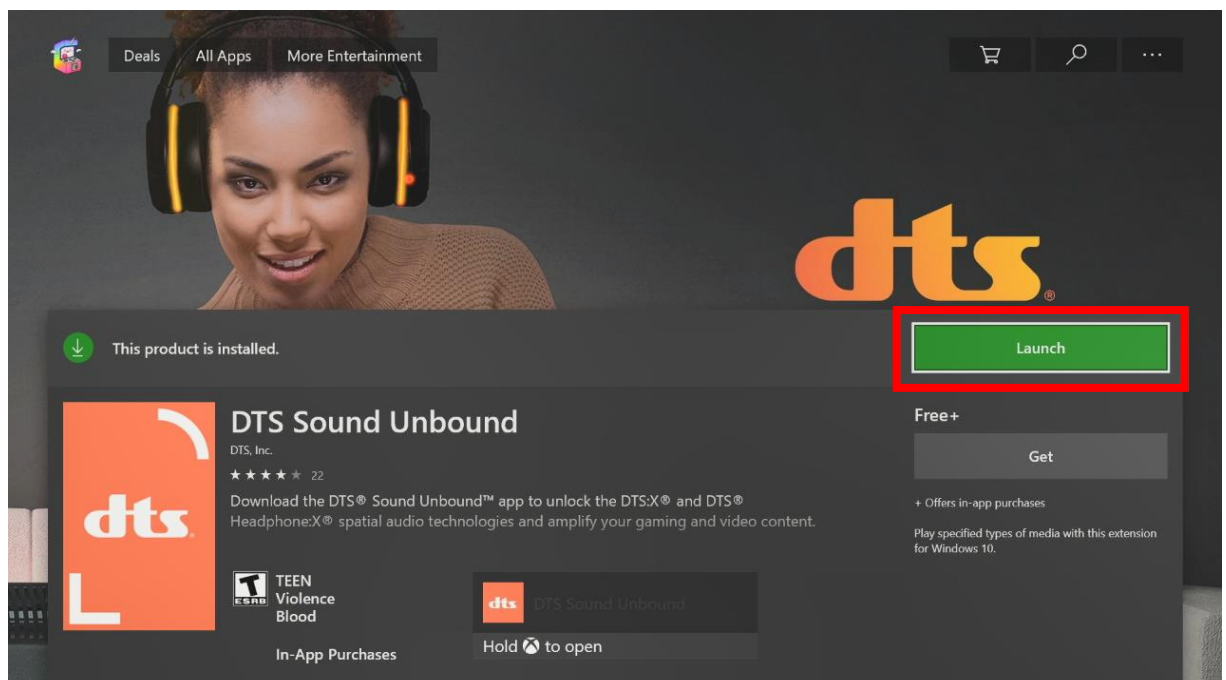

6. After closing the page you will be redirected to the Store page of the DTS Sound Unbound application; click "Install"

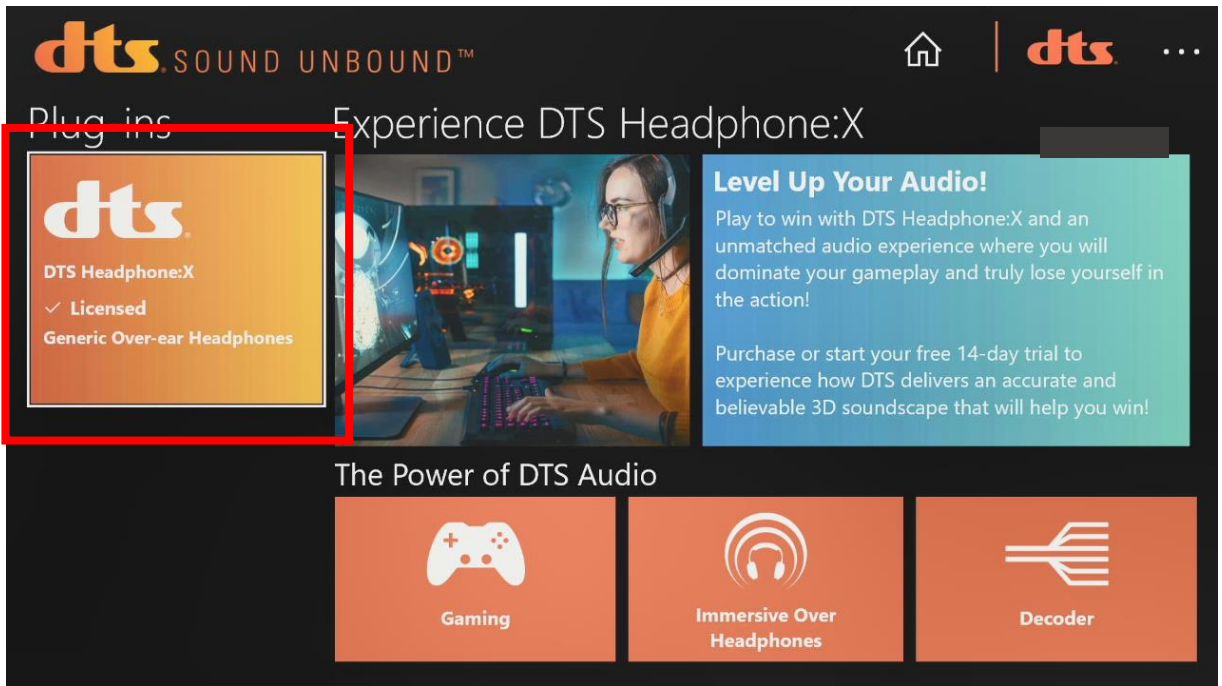


7. After install, select "Launch"

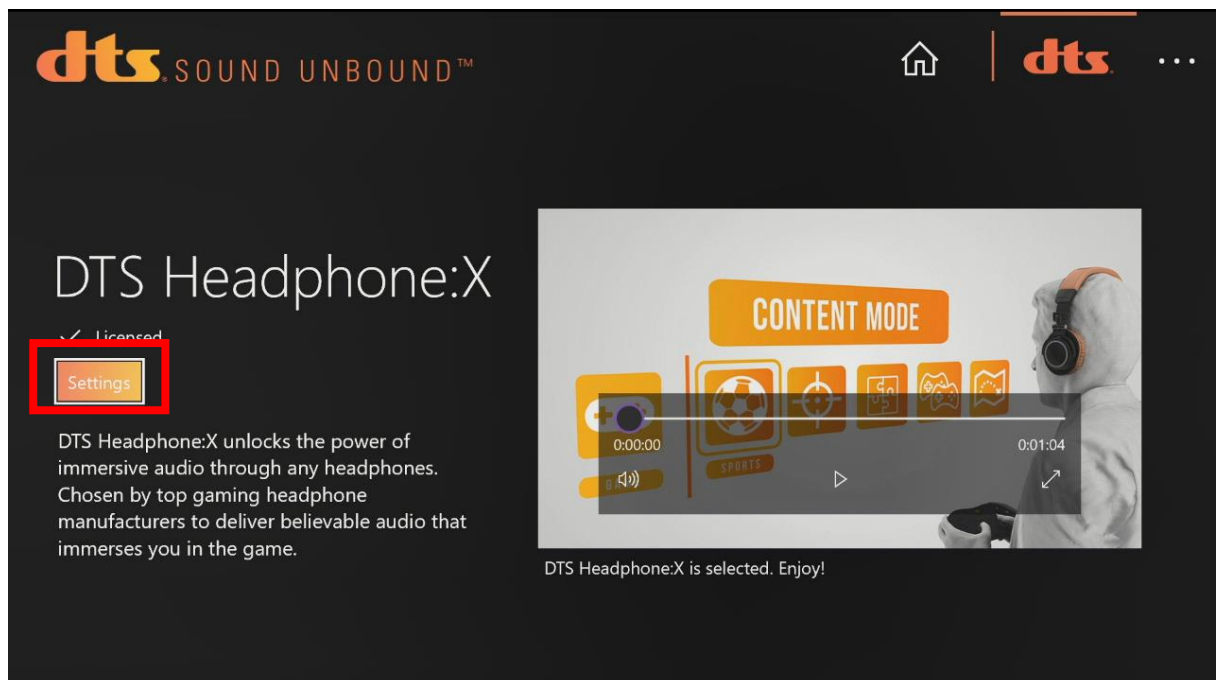

8. To set-up your system, select the DTS tile

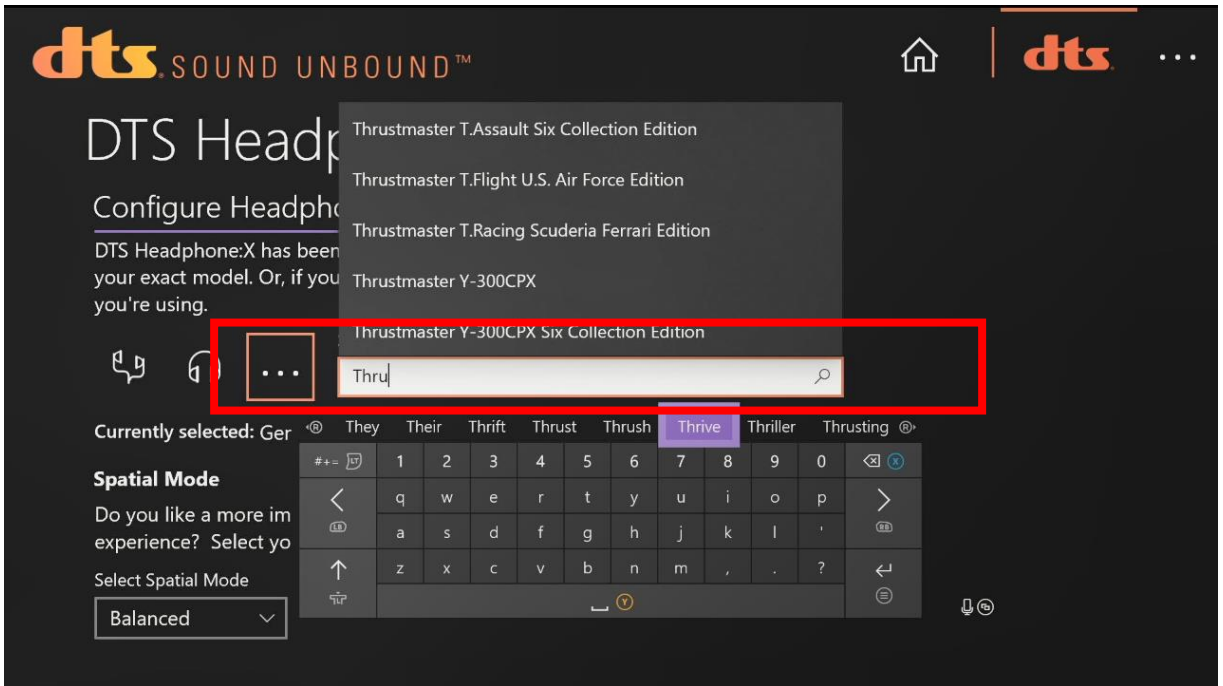


9. Select "Settings"

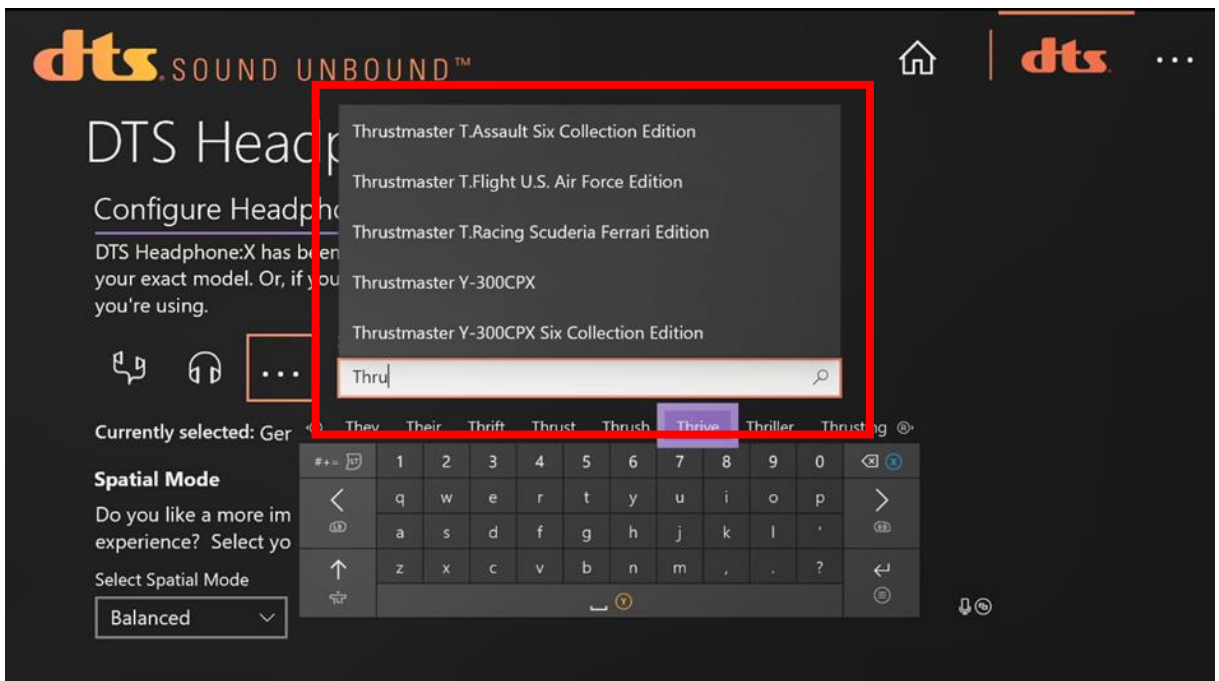

10. Select the three dots to activate the search bar, then type in "Thrustmaster":

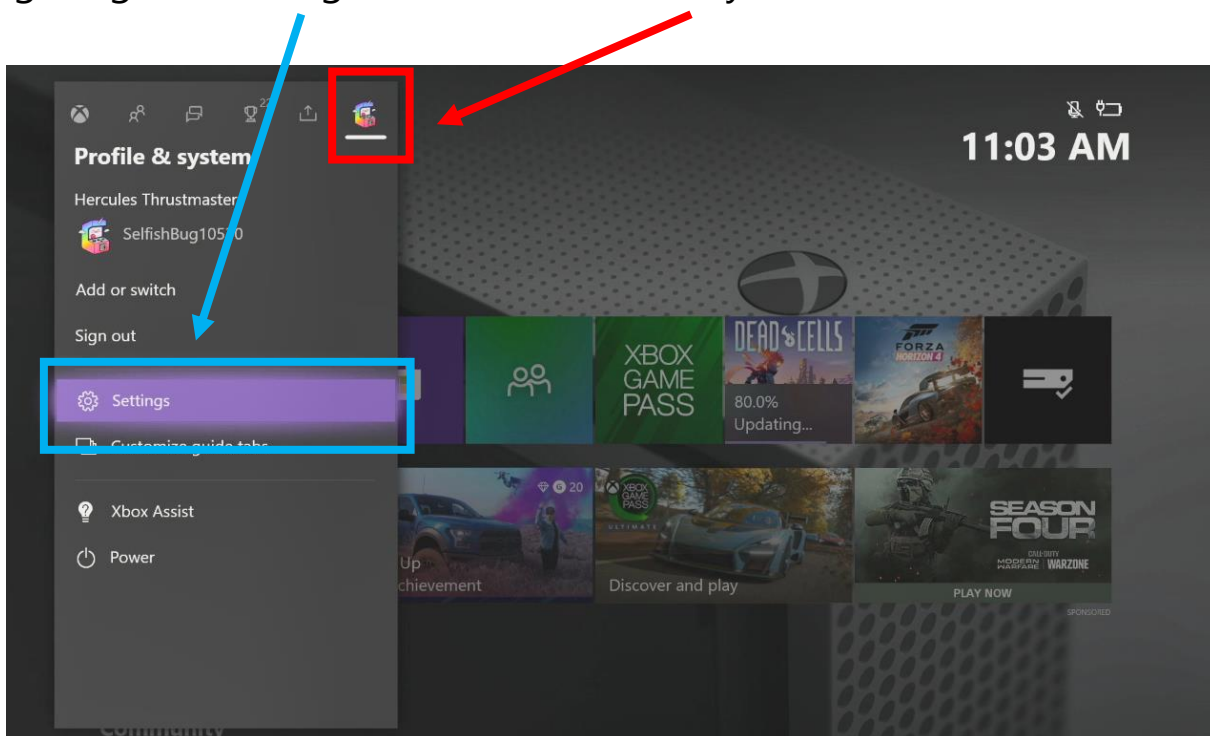


11. Select your headset model in the dropdown menu; this will activate the recommended EQ setting specifically created by DTS for your Thrustmaster headset.

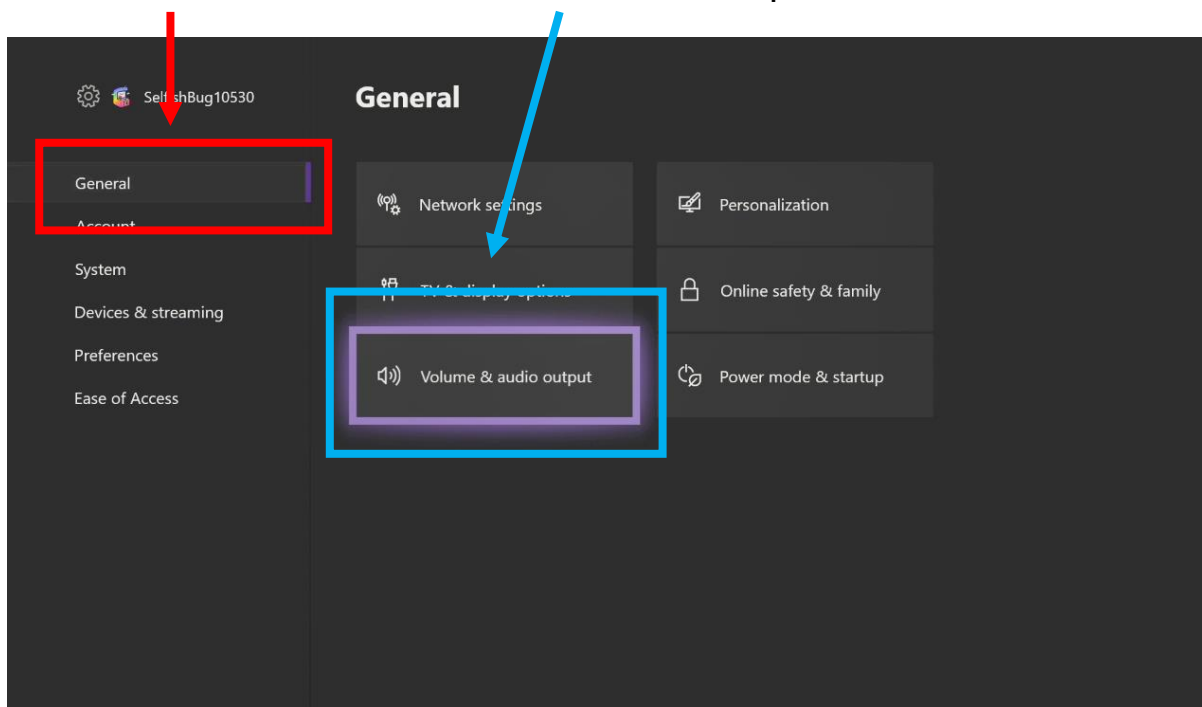

**12.** To ensure DTS Headphone:X has been properly activated, go to the system settings by pressing the Xbox button on your controller and navigating to "Settings" in the "Profile & System" tab:

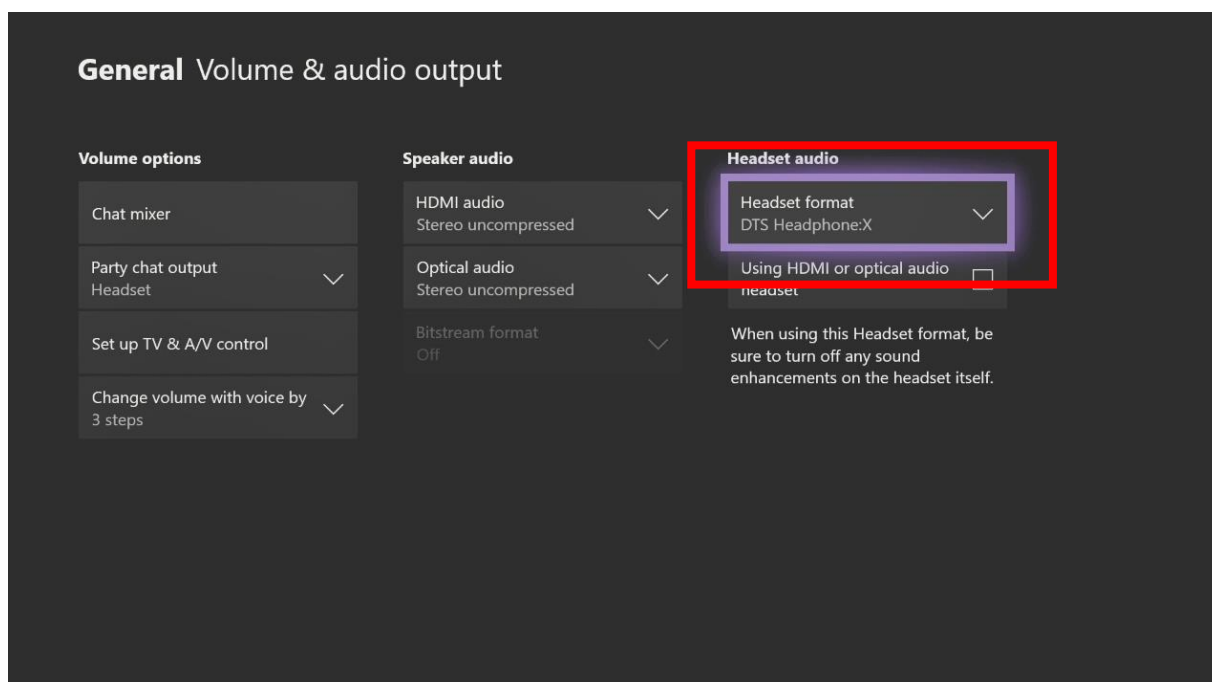


**13.** In "General", select "Volume & audio output":

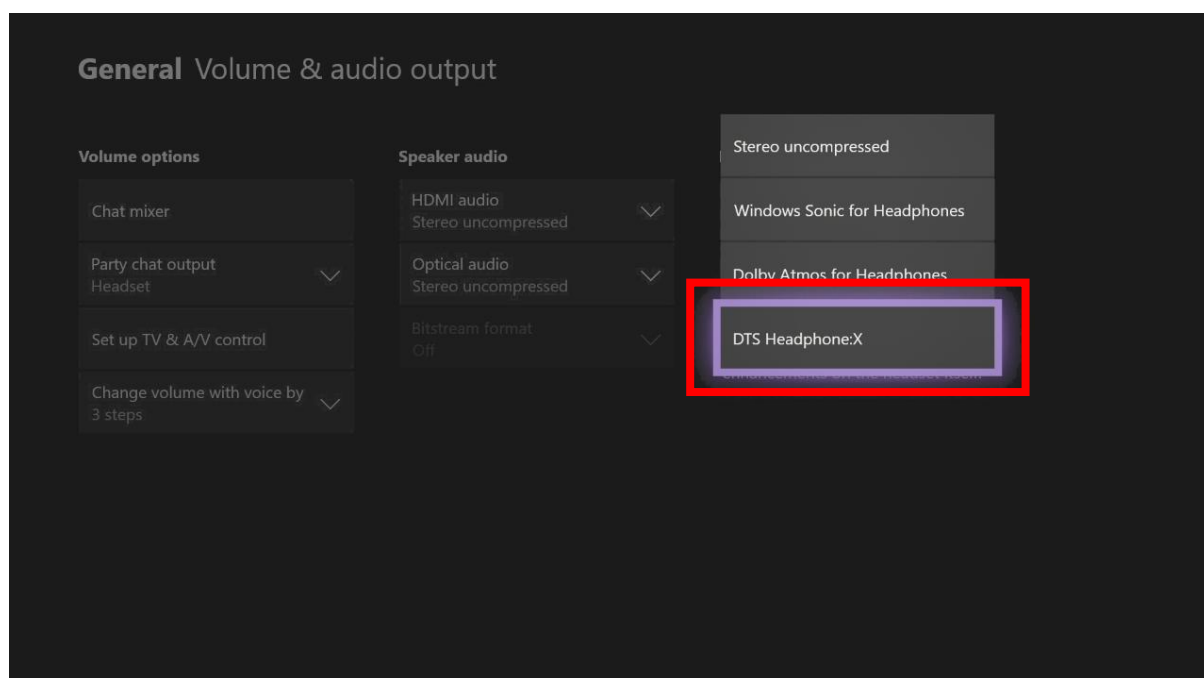
